We demand: Women's Rights Now!

„Women's rights are human rights!“ was stated by the UN Human Rights Conference in Vienna 20 years ago. „All forms of violence against women must end“, demanded female activists from all over the world.

Until today Women's rights have not been - despite useful legislation - put into practice in an effective and sufficient way in most countries in the world:

- There is a considerable amount of gender based violence in every day life, situations of conflict and war: Stop with impunity for perpetrators!
- The (financial) crisis must not be settled on the backs of women: We demand access to paid and dignified work, living, education, health services and child care! End privatization and corruption in our economies!
- Female migrants often experience exploitation and discrimination: We demand guaranteed rights to work and residence and social protection for all, including female migrants!
- Women must have the right to decide freely about their own body, about whom they love, if and how many children they want to have: We want sexual and reproductive rights for all!
- Religious and cultural fundamentalism can never justify the violation of women's rights: We demand protection from reactionary assaults!

That is why we roll out the red carpet for women's rights today and we demand:

Stumbling blocks out of the way, women's rights now!
